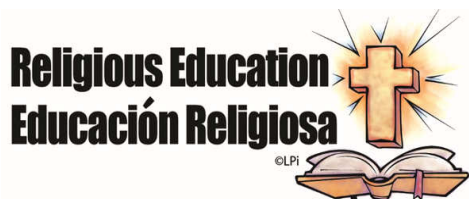

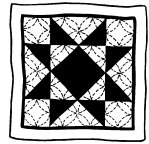

Holy Father Pope Francis is visiting Colombia:

“Accepting the invitation of the President of the Republic and the Colombian bishops, His Holiness the Pope Francis will make an Apostolic Trip to Colombia from 6 to 11 September 2017, visiting the cities of Bogotá, Villavicencio, Medellín and Cartagena. The program for the trip will be published shortly.”



The logo of the Journey contains the motto of the Pope’s Apostolic Journey: “Let’s take the first step” [Demos el primer paso]. A message accompanying the logo says the words refer to "the more than 50 years of violence" which divided Colombia.

“The visit of Pope Francis to Colombia is a moment of grace and happiness in order to dream about the possibility of transforming our country and taking the first step. The Holy Father is a missionary of reconciliation.” During his six-day visit to Colombia in September, Pope Francis will beatify martyrs Bishop Jesús Emilio Jaramillo Monsalve and Father Pedro María Ramírez Ramos, who provide a potent testimony as the country heals from decades of conflict. Jaramillo was killed by Colombian Marxist guerilla forces in 1989, while Ramirez was murdered at the start of the Colombian Civil War in 1948.

The two were recognized as martyrs by the Vatican earlier this year, and will be beatified during the Pope’s Sept. 6-12 visit to Colombia, which he is making largely to encourage efforts for peace and reconciliation after more than 50 years of violent conflict that has left some 200,000 people dead. Given the nature of their deaths, the two can be seen as belonging to a new wave of “modern martyrs” Pope Francis has often referred to, killed by oppressive regimes of their time such as Nazism, communism and brutal dictatorships.

OGOTÁ, 26 Ago. 17 / 03:28 pm (ACI).- La Conferencia Episcopal de Colombia (CEC) invitó a todos los fieles del país sudamericano a participar de la gran vigilia de oración con la que esperarán la llegada del Papa Francisco. Este gran evento se realizará el 5 de septiembre, un día antes de la llegada del Pontífice a Colombia y están invitados a participar obispos, sacerdotes, religiosos y la comunidad en general.

La invitación la hace la CEC y el Comité Teológico Pastoral de la Visita Apostólica para que ese día “todas las parroquias, hogares, casas religiosas, seminarios y movimientos laicales del país” organicen “actividades haciendo un recorrido, desde la familia, en cada uno de los temas que el Papa tratará en las cuatro ciudades”. El Papa estará en Colombia del 6 al 10 de septiembre y visitará las ciudades de Bogotá, Villavicencio, Medellín y Cartagena.

Los temas son “Familia artesana de la paz y defensora de la vida”, “La familia escuela de reconciliación”, “La familia semillero de vocaciones”, y “La familia defensora de la dignidad y los derechos humanos”. El papa Francisco beatificará el próximo 8 de septiembre en Villavicencio, Colombia, a dos religiosos colombianos: el obispo de Arauca Jesús Emilio Jaramillo Monsalve y el sacerdote Pedro María Ramírez Ramos, conocido como el "mártir de Armero", confirmó este lunes la Conferencia Episcopal.
