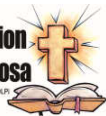

Child martyrs and priests to become saints

(Vatican Radio) Dozens of martyrs from the Americas along with two zealous priests of Italy and Spain are to be **canonized** by **Pope Francis**. Pilgrims will gather in St Peter's Square on Sunday, October 15, 2017 to witness the canonization of three Mexican teenagers known as the "**Child Martyrs of Tlaxcala**".

Cristobal, Antonio, and Juan were murdered in the 1520s after being caught destroying pagan idols following their conversions to the Catholic faith. Among the other new saints will be the **Martyrs of Natal**, Brazil. Fathers Andrea de Soveral and Ambrogio Francesco Ferro were martyred in 1645 during a persecution of the Catholic Church by Dutch Calvinists. Layman Matteo Moreira and 27 companions, were also killed during two separate violent attacks – one during Mass celebrated by Fr de Soveral, and another on a group of Catholics including Fr Ferro.

A Spanish priest of the 19th century, **Blessed Faustino Míguez**, who founded a religious congregation to educate women, will also be canonized alongside Capuchin friar **Blessed Angelo D'Acri**, a renowned confessor and evangelize in southern Italy during the 18th century.

El Papa declarará santos a mártires de Brasil y niños mártires de Tlaxcala en México

VATICANO, 09 Oct. 17 / 11:46 am (**ACI**).- La Oficina de Prensa del Vaticano informó que el Papa Francisco presidirá la canonización de 35 nuevos santos el próximo domingo 15 de octubre.

La nota señala que el Santo Padre “celebrará la Misa y presidirá el rito de canonización de los beatos: André de Soveral, Ambrosio Francesco Ferro, Mateus Moreira y 27 compañeros, Antonio, Juan y Cristóforo (niños mexicanos mártires de Tlaxcala), Faustino Míguez (sacerdote español) y Angelo de Acri (fraile italiano)”.

André de Soveral, Ambrosio Francesco Ferro, Mateus Moreira y 27 compañeros son los llamados protomártires de Brasil, asesinados por odio a la fe entre 1630 y 1654, cuando los holandeses calvinistas en el país quisieron obligar a los católicos para que se conviertan y prohibieron la celebración de la Santa Misa.

El P. André de Soveral y otros 70 fieles fueron asesinados el 16 de julio de 1645, a manos de 200 soldados holandeses junto con indios potiguares, en la Capilla de Nossa Senhora das Candeias, en Engenho Cunhaú, municipio de Canguaretama en el estado de Río Grande del Norte.

Tres meses después, el 3 de octubre de 1645, ocurrió la masacre de Uruaçu, donde fueron asesinados el P. Ambrosio Francisco Ferro y el laico Mateus Moreira. Según los relatos, antes de que le arrancaran el corazón, pudo gritar: “¡Alabado sea el Santísimo Sacramento!”

De otro lado, en diciembre de 2016, el Papa aprobó el milagro realizado por intercesión del Beato Faustino Míguez, sacerdote español de la Orden de los Clérigos regulares Pobres de la Madre de Dios de las Escuelas Pías (Escolapios) y fundador de la Congregación de las Hermanas Calasancias Hijas de la Divina Pastora.

Otro de los beatos que será declarado santo es Angelo de Acri, sacerdote de la Orden de los Frailes Menores Capuchinos, nacido el 9 de octubre de 1669 en Acri, Italia, y fallecido el 30 de octubre de 1739.
