and small domestic churches.

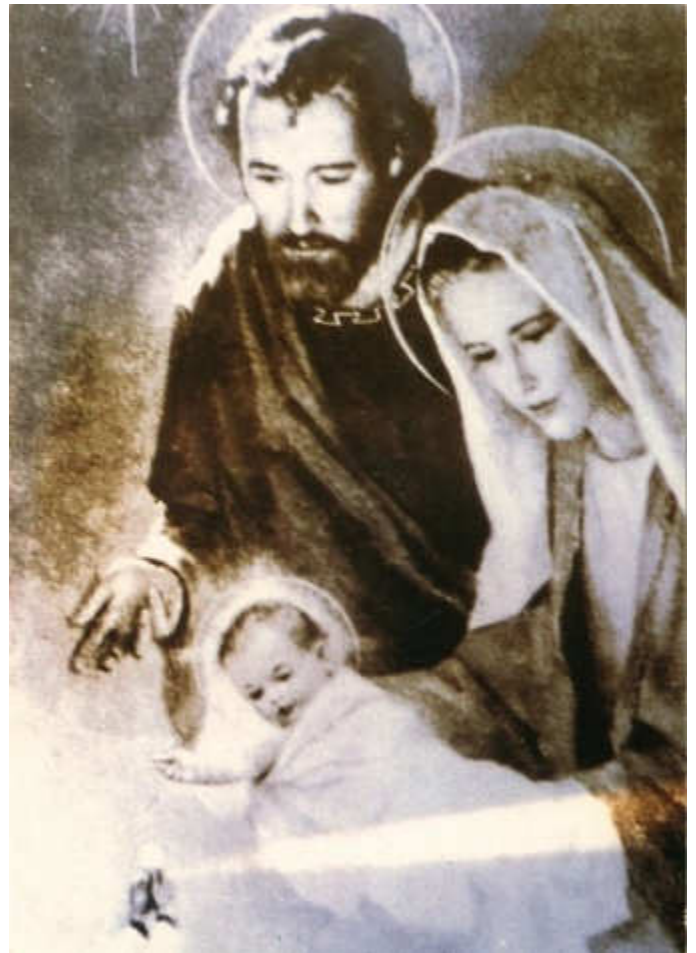
Holy Family of Nazareth,

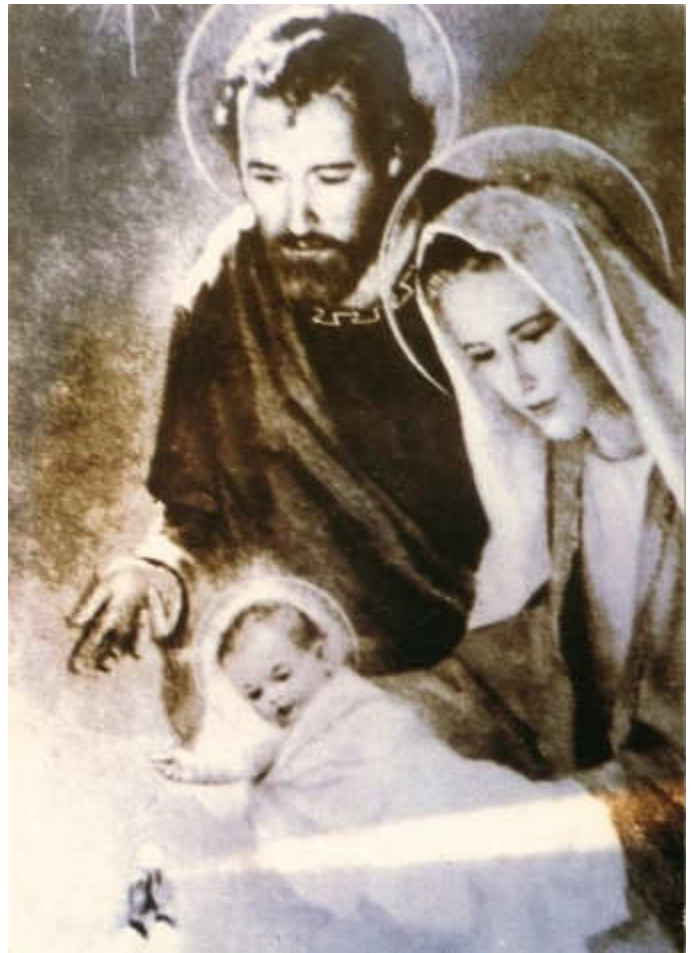

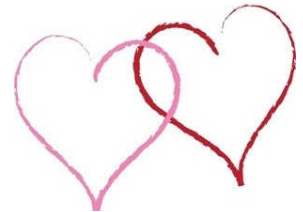
