## March lauded for witnessing to life; participation in '9 Days' urged

WASHINGTON (CNS) -- In a message of support for the March for Life in Washington, a Vatican official praised "the tens of thousands" of participants for their witness to the "value of every human life" and for upholding the dignity of life from conception to natural death. "You give witness to the world of your understanding of the value of every human life and of your commitment to welcome, nurture, protect and integrate every human life from the first moment of conception until natural death," said Archbishop Vincenzo Paglia, president of the Pontifical Academy for Life. He made the remarks in a statement dated Jan. 19, the day of this year's march, and addressed to March for Life officials. It also was sent to Cardinal Daniel N. DiNardo of Galveston-Houston, president of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops; Cardinal Donald W. Wuerl of Washington; and Bishop Michael F. Burbidge of Arlington, Virginia. In a Jan. 16 statement, New York Cardinal Timothy M. Dolan, chairman of the USCCB Committee on Pro-life Activities, urged Catholics and others across the country to get involved in the "9 Days for Life" prayer and Action Campaign Jan. 18-26. "Our prayers matter," he said. The campaign's website is [www.9daysforlife.com](http://www.9daysforlife.com). "We bring many needs to God this month, including care for displaced persons, racial harmony, Christian unity and the protection of all human life," Cardinal Dolan said. "Every prayer matters, and if you can't start at the beginning, jump in when you can!"

"9 Days for Life" is the U.S. bishops' annual, pro-life prayer and action campaign surrounding the anniversary of the Supreme Court's 1973 decisions in *Roe v. Wade* and *Doe v. Bolton* that legalized abortion throughout all nine months of pregnancy. The overarching intention of novena at the center of the event is the end to abortion, and each day treats a different aspect of respecting the dignity of the human person -- from the beginning of life to its natural end.

This year, as part of the Catholic Church's "Share the Journey" campaign supporting displaced persons, one day addresses human trafficking, something migrants and refugees are particularly at risk of suffering. Participants can make a "digital pilgrimage." They are encouraged to build "a culture of life" through prayer and action and by sharing their experiences on social media with the hashtags #9DaysforLife and #Our Prayers Matter. There also is a Facebook frame participants can use on their profile picture to show their support for life. In his letter, Archbishop Paglia assured March for Life attendees of his prayers "for the fruitfulness of your undertaking that is so filled with love." He was certain that on Jan. 19 in particular "you will have the blessings and grateful prayers of all the innocent lives for whom you have, over so many years, cared and struggled."

Archbishop Paglia recalled his own participation in the march "one very cold January day more than 20 years ago." He added: "I join with Cardinal Wuerl of Washington and Bishop Burbidge of Arlington, with all my brother Catholic and Orthodox bishops in the United States, and with all the members of the Vatican's Pontifical Academy for Life, in honoring what you do and who you are, and in encouraging you always to remember the love that God has for you his "good and faithful servants."



## Arzobispo de Nueva York invita a participar en campaña de oración "9 Días por la Vida"

El Arzobispo de Nueva York y Presidente del Comité de Actividades Provida de la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de Estados Unidos, Cardenal Timothy Dolan, invitó a los católicos y al público en general a unirse a la campaña nacional de oración 9 Días por la Vida.

"Traemos muchas necesidades a Dios este mes, incluyendo el cuidado de las personas desplazadas, la armonía racial, la unidad de los cristianos y la protección de toda la vida humana. Nuestras oraciones importan. Cada oración importa, y si no puedes comenzar desde el principio, ¡salta cuando puedas!", dijo el Cardenal Dolan en un comunicado el 16 de enero.

9 Days for Life, que irá desde el jueves 18 hasta el viernes 26 de enero, es la campaña anual de oración y acción provida de los obispos de los Estados Unidos con motivo del aniversario de la decisión de la Corte Suprema que en 1973 legalizó el aborto en todo el país.

"La intención general de la novena central es el fin del aborto, y cada día trata un aspecto diferente del respeto de la dignidad de la persona humana, desde el comienzo de la vida hasta su final natural", sostiene el comunicado.

Para este año, como parte de la campaña "Comparta el viaje" que apoya a las personas desplazadas, un día se abordará la trata de personas. Respondiendo a la invitación de los obispos, los participantes pueden realizar una "peregrinación digital".

"Uniéndose a decenas de miles en todo el país, pueden construir una cultura provida a través de la oración y acción, y compartir sus experiencias en las redes sociales con los hashtags #9DaysforLife y #OurPrayersMatter. También hay un marco de Facebook que los participantes pueden usar en su foto de perfil para mostrar su apoyo", prosigue el comunicado.

Finalmente, en el mensaje se indica que el sitio web [www.9daysforlife.com](http://www.9daysforlife.com), presenta un video con el Cardenal Dolan llamando a la campaña "una excelente manera de poner nuestra fe en acción".

"El sitio ofrece una versión impresa de la novena, así como cuatro formas de recibir automáticamente el diario oraciones, reflexiones y acciones sugeridas en inglés o español: app gratuita "9 Días por la Vida" (con recordatorios personalizables), correo electrónico, mensaje de texto y un evento de Facebook", concluye el comunicado.
