Fr. Camilo's Pastoral Letter—Month of February 2018

Dear Parishioners of Corpus Christi,

“Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.”

On February 14th will be Ash Wednesday, we will begin the Season of Lent. The scripture readings at Mass will speak to us of fasting, weeping and mourning; of the need for prayer, and almsgiving. Reflecting on Pope John Paul II in his Apostolic Letter to the Church at the beginning of this new millennium in which he said that all of us who are disciples of Christ *“Must gain a new impetus in Christian living, making it the force which inspires our journey of faith. Conscious of the Risen Lord’s presence among us, we ask ourselves today the same question put to Peter in Jerusalem immediately after his Pentecost speech: “What must we do?” (Acts 2:37). We put the question with trusting optimism, but without underestimating the problems we face. We are certainly not seduced by the naive expectation that faced with the great challenges of our time; we shall find some magic formula. No, we shall not be saved by a formula but by a Person, and the assurance which he gives us: I am with you!*

It is not therefore a matter of inventing a “new program”. The program already exists: it is the plan found in the Gospel and in the living Tradition, it is the same as ever. Ultimately, it has its center in Christ himself, who is to be known, loved and imitated, so that in him we may live the life of the Trinity, and with him transform history until its fulfillment in the heavenly Jerusalem. This is a program which does not change with shifts of times and cultures, even though it takes account of time and culture for the sake of true dialogue and effective communication.” (Novo Millennio Ineunte n.29).

So as we begin Lent, we should all be asking the question, “What shall we do?” Lent is a time when we are called to repentance, and to put God more consciously at the very Centre of our lives once again. The traditional ways of repentance are prayer, fasting and almsgiving. And in Matthew’s gospel, Jesus, in the Sermon on the Mount, tells us how to go about it. In order to do as the Lord asks of us, our hearts must be united with his heart; we must come to know him, and abide with him ever more deeply and with ever greater commitment, day by day.

Wishing you a fruitful Lent and let’s pray for each other,

Carta Pastoral del Padre Camilo—mes de febrero 2018

**Estimado Feligreses de Corpus Christi,
“Les deseo la Paz de Cristo Jesús Dios nuestro Padre y el Señor Jesucristo”**

El 14 de febrero daremos inicio, a tiempo santo de Cuaresma con el miércoles de ceniza. Las lecturas de la Misa nos hablarán de ayuno, oración y caridad;. Reflexionando sobre la Encíclica del Papa San Juan Pablo II en su Carta Apostólica *“La Iglesia al comienzo de este nuevo milenio, en la que dijo que todos los que somos discípulos de Cristo debemos obtener un nuevo ímpetu en la vida cristiana, convirtiéndola en la fuerza que inspira nuestra viaje de fe. Conscientes de la presencia del Señor resucitado entre nosotros, hoy nos hacemos la misma pregunta que le hicimos a Pedro en Jerusalén inmediatamente después de su discurso de Pentecostés: “¿Qué debemos hacer?” (Hechos 2:37). Nos pregunta con confiado optimismo, pero sin subestimar los problemas que enfrentamos. Ciertamente, no nos seduce la ingenua expectativa que enfrentan los grandes desafíos de nuestro tiempo; encontraremos alguna fórmula mágica. No, no seremos salvos por una fórmula, sino por una Persona, y la seguridad que nos da: ¡estoy con ustedes!*

Por lo tanto, no se trata de inventar un "nuevo programa". El programa ya existe: es el plan que se encuentra en el Evangelio y en la Tradición viva, es el mismo de siempre. En última instancia, tiene su centro en Cristo mismo, que debe ser conocido, amado e imitado, para que en él podamos vivir la vida de la Trinidad y con él transformar la historia hasta su cumplimiento en la Jerusalén celestial. Este es un programa que no cambia con los cambios de tiempos y culturas, a pesar de que toma en cuenta el tiempo y la cultura por el verdadero diálogo y la comunicación efectiva.” (Novo Millennio Ineunte n.29).

Entonces, al comenzar la Cuaresma, todos deberíamos hacernos la pregunta: "¿Qué haremos?". La Cuaresma es un tiempo en el que somos llamados al arrepentimiento y a poner a Dios más conscientemente en el mismo centro de nuestras vidas una vez más. Las formas tradicionales de arrepentimiento son la oración, el ayuno y la limosna. Y en el evangelio de Mateo, Jesús, en el Sermón del Monte, nos dice cómo hacerlo. Para hacer lo que el Señor nos pide, nuestros corazones deben estar unidos con su corazón; debemos llegar a conocerlo, y permanecer con él cada vez más profundamente y con un compromiso cada vez mayor, día a día.

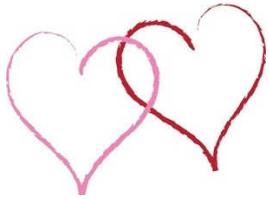
