## Ash Wednesday trumps Valentine's, Chicago archdiocese says

Chicago, Ill., Jan 29, 2018 / 11:59 am ([CNA/EWTN News](#)).- Occasionally, the liturgical calendar has a curious intersection with secular holidays. This year, Ash Wednesday—which begins the penitential season of Lent with a day of fasting, abstinence, and prayer—falls on Feb. 14, Valentine's Day. Valentine's Day celebrates a third-century Christian martyr, but it has also become a celebration of romantic love, replete with chocolates, fancy prix fixe menus, roses, and an overload of candy hearts.

The Archdiocese of Chicago has clarified that Lent is more important than candy hearts, and suggested that Catholics pick some other day for paper hearts and Cupid's arrows. A [statement released](#) by the Archdiocese explained that Catholics will not be dispensed from the laws of fasting and abstinence on Ash Wednesday, and suggested that Catholics planning to celebrate Valentine's Day could do so on Feb. 13th, which is also Mardi Gras.

“The obligation of fast and abstinence must naturally be the priority in the Catholic community,” said the statement. “Valentine's Day can appropriately be celebrated the Tuesday before Ash Wednesday which also happens to be Mardi Gras, a traditionally festive time before beginning our Lenten observance.”

Mardi Gras is traditionally celebrated each year on the Tuesday before Ash Wednesday. Customary Mardi Gras celebrations include parades, elaborate costumes, and the consumption of pancakes. In the Archdiocese of Chicago, it might also serve as a substitute Valentine's Day.

Catholics 18-59 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Catholics 14 and older are also required to abstain from meat on those days, and on Lenten Fridays. [According to the US bishops' conference](#), a person fasting “is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.”

# La Arquidiócesis de Chicago hace una Declaración sobre el Miércoles de Ceniza 2018.

Este año el 14 de febrero, día de San Valentín o Día de los enamorados, coincidirá con el Miércoles de Ceniza y muchos católicos se preguntan si acaso ¿es obligatorio ayunar y abstenerse de comer carne ese día?

Como respuesta a la duda de varios fieles, la Arquidiócesis de Chicago en Estados Unidos emitió un comunicado en el que afirma que “la obligación de ayunar y la abstinencia deben ser naturalmente la prioridad de la comunidad católica” debido a que el Miércoles de Ceniza marca el comienzo de la Cuaresma.

Asimismo, sostiene que ese día los católicos **no serán dispensados de las leyes de ayuno y abstinencia**. “Los católicos de todo el mundo reconocen el Miércoles de Ceniza como el comienzo solemne de un período de reflexión y penitencia en oración, como es evidente por la gran cantidad de asistentes a la iglesia en este día”, explicó la Arquidiócesis.

Luego, se sugirió que los católicos que desean celebrar el día de San Valentín podrían hacerlo el día anterior, el martes 13 de febrero. El Día de San Valentín celebra a un mártir cristiano del siglo III, pero también se ha convertido en una celebración romántica, repleta de chocolates, menús de lujo, rosas, entre otros obsequios.

El Miércoles de Ceniza es **obligatorio el ayuno y la abstinencia, como en el Viernes Santo, para los mayores de 18 años y menores de 60**. Fuera de esos límites es opcional. Ese día los fieles pueden tener una comida “fuerte” una sola vez al día, complementada con dos comidas más pequeñas que juntas no son iguales a la comida completa. El Miércoles de Ceniza cayó por última vez el 14 de febrero en 1945, antes de que la celebración secular del Día de San Valentín se hiciera popular. La fecha coincidirá nuevamente en 2024 y también en 2029.

Pope Francis told Peruvian youth that Jesus doesn't want disciples who have been "photoshopped" to perfection, but like the great saints of the past, God calls people to follow him with trust and enthusiasm, despite their weaknesses.

"When Jesus looks at us, he does not think about how perfect we are, but about all the love we have in our hearts to give in serving others," the Pope said Jan. 21.



With technology it's easy to digitally enhance photos to make them look the way we want, but this only works for pictures, he said. "We cannot 'photoshop' others, the world, or ourselves. Color filtering and high definition only function well in video; we can never apply them to our friends."

These pictures might turn out nice, but they are "completely fake," the Pope said, and assured the youth that their hearts "can't be 'photoshopped,' because that's where authentic love and genuine happiness have to be found."

"Jesus does not want you to have a cosmetic heart," he said. "He loves you as you are, and he has a dream for every one of you. Do not forget, he does not get discouraged with us."
