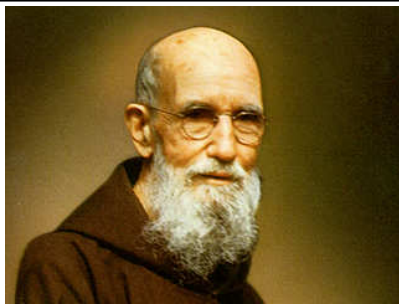

Fr. Solanus Casey: the American priest to be beatified November 18th

Venerable Solanus Casey, an American-born Capuchin priest who died in 1957, will be beatified at a Nov. 18 Mass in Detroit.

Who was Fr. Solanus Casey? Known for his great faith, attention to the sick, and ability as a spiritual counselor, he will be the second American-born male to be beatified.

Born Bernard Casey on Nov. 25, 1870, he was the sixth child of 16 born to Irish immigrants in Wisconsin. At age 17 he left home to work at various jobs, including as a lumberjack, a hospital orderly, and a prison guard.

Re-evaluating his life after witnessing a drunken sailor brutally stab a woman to death, he decided to act on a call he felt to enter the priesthood. Because of his lack of formal education, however, he struggled in the minor seminary, and was eventually encouraged to become a priest through a religious order rather than through the diocese. So in 1898, he joined the Capuchin Franciscans in Detroit and after struggling through his studies, in 1904 was ordained a "sacerdos simplex" – a priest who can say Mass, but not publicly preach or hear confessions.

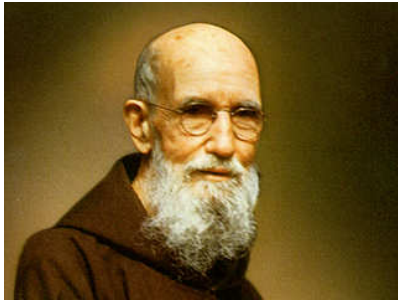
He was very close to the sick and was highly sought-after throughout his life, in part because of the many physical healings attributed to his blessings and intercession. He was also a co-founder of Detroit's Capuchin Soup Kitchen in 1929.

For 21 years he was porter at St. Bonaventure Monastery in Detroit. He is also known for his fondness for playing the violin and singing, although he had a bad singing voice because of a childhood illness which damaged his vocal chords. Even in his 70s, Fr. Solanus Casey remained very active, and would even join the younger religious men in a game of tennis or volleyball. He died from erysipelas, a skin disease, on July 31, 1957, at the age of 87.

A miracle attributed to Venerable Casey's intercession was recognized by Pope Francis at a May 4 meeting with Cardinal Angelo Amato, prefect of the Congregation for the Causes of Saints. "I'm grateful to hear from the Capuchin friars that the date of the beatification has been finalized," Archbishop Allen Vigneron of Detroit stated.

"The beatification of Father Solanus will be a tremendous blessing for the whole community of southeast Michigan, an opportunity for all of us to experience the love of Jesus Christ."

The Nov. 18 beatification Mass will be said at Ford Field in Detroit, which can accommodate as many as 60,000.



Beatificaron en Estados Unidos a sacerdote franciscano que fue portero durante 21 años

El venerable Solanus Casey, sacerdote capuchino estadounidense conocido por su gran capacidad de consejero espiritual y que sirvió como portero de un monasterio durante 21 años, será beatificado el próximo 18 de noviembre en la ciudad de Detroit, en el estado de Michigan.

De esta manera, el venerable Casey se convertirá en el segundo hombre nacido en Estados Unidos en ser beatificado. “Es una hermosa manera de celebrar el 60 aniversario de su fallecimiento”, agregó el sacerdote. La Misa de beatificación se realizará en el estadio Ford Field de Detroit, que cuenta con una capacidad de 60 mil personas.

El venerable Casey era conocido por su gran fe, atención a los enfermos y su capacidad para dar consejería espiritual. Bernard Casey nació el 25 de noviembre de 1870. Fue el sexto de los 16 hijos de una pareja de inmigrantes irlandeses en Wisconsin. A los 17 años se fue de su casa para trabajar en varios trabajos, incluyendo de leñador, camillero de un hospital, y como guardia en una prisión.

Después de presenciar la escena en que un marinero borracho apuñaló brutalmente a una mujer, comenzó a reevaluar su vida y decidió escuchar la llamada de Dios que sentía para seguir el sacerdocio. La falta de educación formal hizo muy exigente su paso por el seminario menor y finalmente le aconsejaron ingresar a una orden religiosa en lugar de ser sacerdote diocesano.

En 1898 se unió a los franciscanos capuchinos en Detroit y después de concluir sus estudios, en 1904 fue ordenado “*sacerdos simplex*”, es decir, un sacerdote que solo puede celebrar Misa pero no predicar públicamente ni escuchar confesiones. Siempre estuvo muy cerca de los enfermos y muchos acudían a él, en parte debido a las numerosas curaciones físicas atribuidas a sus bendiciones e intercesión. También fue cofundador de proyecto “*Capuchin Soup Kitchen*”, una iniciativa de ayuda a los más necesitados de Detroit en 1929, el año del Crack.

El Crack de 1929 fue la más devastadora caída del mercado de valores en la historia de la Bolsa en Estados Unidos, lo que lugar a una grave crisis conocida como “La Gran Depresión”. Durante 21 años fue portero en el monasterio de San Buenaventura en Detroit. También fue conocido por su afición al violín y al canto, aunque su voz no era afinada debido a una enfermedad infantil que dañó sus cuerdas vocales. Murió de erisipela, una enfermedad de la piel, el 31 de julio de 1957 a los 87 años.

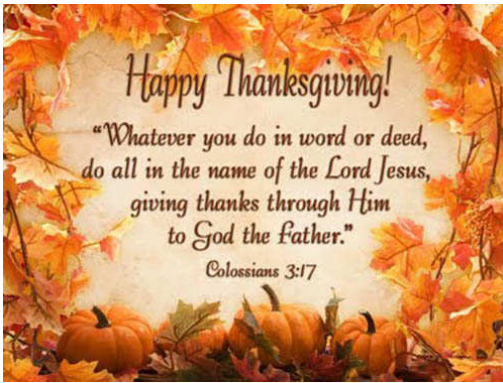
