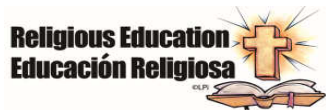

Fr. Camilo's Pastoral Letter for the Month of May.

Dear Parishioners of Corpus Christi, *"Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ"*.

The arrival of May always fills our souls with a special joy. The joy of Easter is reinforced by the beginning of several weeks dedicated especially to our Lady, in many countries.

I want to consider once again with joy and gratitude that the first day of May it is the feast of St. Joseph the Worker. The feast of St. Joseph the Worker invites us to remember the transcendent value of honest professional work that is well done, with the desire of giving glory to God and serving our neighbor, independently of the importance society attributes to it.

However, the month of May speaks to us above all of our Lady's continual presence on the path of the Church and of every Catholic. On May 13th, this year, falls the Solemnity of the Ascension of Our Lord and we will welcome our Bishop Peter, who is coming to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation. This year 17 youth will be receiving the fullness of the Holy Spirit.

Mother's Day is just around the corner, and is a special day when we celebrate the beauty of motherhood and take time to appreciate our individual mothers and mother figures. *"The wise woman builds her house, but with her own hands the foolish one tears hers down"*. *Proverbs (14:1)*. In this month the Holy Mother Church encourages us to pray the vocal prayer, especially the Rosary, so strongly recommended by our Lady to the three young shepherds. During the following days of the month, we can closely accompany our Lady in preparing for the feast of Pentecost, which this year is celebrated on Sunday the 27th. *"With Mary begins the earthly life of Jesus, and with Mary the first steps of the Church also begin."* God wanted his Son to become flesh in the most pure womb of the Virgin, and our Lord gave her to us as Mother, beside the Cross.

I want to conclude this Pastoral Letter with this citation from St. Paul. *"Since, then, we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, 'I believed, therefore I spoke,' we too, believe and therefore speak, knowing that the one who raised the Lord Jesus will raise us also with Jesus and place us with you in his presence"* (2 Cor 4:13-14).

Carta Pastoral del Mes de Mayo

Estimados Feligreses de Corpus Christi, Paz, Gracia y Bendición de Parte de Dios Nuestro Señor y de Cristo Jesús.

La llegada del mes de mayo trae siempre a nuestras almas una particular alegría. Al júbilo pascual se une el comienzo de unas semanas dedicadas especialmente a la Virgen, en gran número de países. Hoy deseo repasar una vez más con vosotros algunos de los motivos de júbilo y de agradecimiento que nos trae este quinto mes del año. Ya el primer día, la fiesta de San José Carpintero. Esta constituye un momento de auténtico *gaudium* para las mujeres y los hombres que, como nosotros, han de buscar la santificación personal y ejercer el apostolado en el trabajo profesional y por medio del quehacer cotidiano. La fiesta de San José Artesano nos invita a no olvidar el valor trascendente de una tarea profesional honrada, bien cumplida, como la que el santo Patriarca desarrolló durante muchos años.

Como condición imprescindible, se requiere realizarla con perfección sobrenatural y humana, es decir, con el deseo de dar gloria a Dios y de servir al prójimo, independientemente de la consideración social que se le atribuya. El mes de mayo nos habla, sobre todo, de la continua presencia de la Santísima Virgen en el camino de la Iglesia y de cada cristiano.

Hacia la mitad del mes, celebraremos tanto la fiesta de la Virgen de Fátima. La Iglesia nos invita a rezar el Santo Rosario, tan recomendado por Nuestra Señora a los tres pastorcillos. El día 13, que este año coincide con la solemnidad de la Ascensión del Señor. En este fin de semana tendremos la grata visita de nuestro Sr. Obispo, Don Pedro que viene celebrar el Sacramento de la Confirmación. Este año 17 jóvenes recibirán la plenitud del Espíritu Santo.

El Día de la Madre o Día de las Madres es una festividad que conmemora a las madres. Se celebra en diferentes fechas del año según el país. “*Mujer virtuosa, quien la hallara? Porque su estima sobrepasa largamente a la de las piedras preciosas.*” Proverbios (31:10)

En las fechas siguientes del mes, podemos acompañar de cerca a Nuestra Señora en la preparación de la fiesta de Pentecostés, que este año se celebra el domingo 27. El Papa Benedicto XVI hacía notar que *con María comienza la vida terrena de Jesús y con María inician también los primeros pasos de la Iglesia* [4]. Recent activities (February-April, 2018) of the Parish Hall building committee include:

- Interviews were conducted to select a company to conduct fundraising for the new hall.
 - Interviews with 3 companies were held in March.
 - Each interview was about 90 minutes.
 - Lynch and Assoc from New York was unanimously selected by the committee.
 - No commitment has been made for a campaign until a feasibility study has been completed.
 - The building committee has made the decision to use Lynch if we proceed with a fundraising campaign.
 - Cost of the feasibility study is \$15,000.
 - Primary reasons for selection.
 - Lynch will assign a person full time for the length of the campaign.
 - The Lynch representative is fluent in Spanish and has extensive missionary work in Mexico.
 - Lynch has a unique program to reach the Hispanic community called "Church in America".
 - Feasibility study will be conducted in early June.
 - The feasibility study will develop a reasonable goal and allow us to develop a realistic budget for building the hall.
 - If we proceed with fundraising, the campaign will kick off in August and be completed in November.
- The design committee continues interviews with various parish ministry leaders.
 - A comprehensive document of recommendations is being developed.
 - Key discussion points include
 - In addition to the current plan, the design committee has also developed an alternate plan.
 - No decision will be made until we have selected an architect to evaluate both plans.
 - Number of classrooms.
 - Use movable walls in hall for 2 additional classrooms to increase total classrooms to 8.
 - Create additional storage areas.
 - Move the food bank to the front of the building.
 - Increase visibility and security.
 - Flexibility in the future for increased hours of operation if necessary.
 - Use of the hall for rental.
 - Pros and cons.
 - A possible source of additional income.
 - Increased maintenance cost and wear and tear on facility.
 - Security issues.
- Visits to other parish halls.
 - Plans to visit at least 2 other parish halls.
 - Visited Mountain Home parish hall.
 - Hall is used extensively for parish and community events.
 - Monthly senior citizen dinners.
 - Movable walls added two additional classrooms.
- Selection of an architect and final plans to be developed over the coming months.
- Town hall meetings to be scheduled after we have an architect and a realistic budget.
- We are still on schedule for spring 2019 ground breaking.
