1. The Agony in the Garden
2. The Scourging at the Pillar
3. The Crowning with Thorns
4. The Carrying of the Cross
5. The Crucifixion and Death

The Five Glorious Mysteries Wednesday and Sundays outside of Lent and Advent

1. The Resurrection
2. The Ascension
3. The Descent of the Holy Spirit
4. The Assumption
5. The Coronation of Mary

The Five Luminous Mysteries Thursday

1. The Baptism of Christ in the Jordan
2. The Wedding Feast at Cana
3. Jesus' Proclamation of the Coming of the Kingdom of God
4. The Transfiguration
5. The Institution of the Eucharist as a Sacrament



## **Praying the Rosary**

Familiarize yourself and/or your group with the prayers of the rosary.

Make the Sign of the Cross.

Holding the Crucifix, say the *Apostles' Creed*.

On the first bead, say an *Our Father*.

Say one *Hail Mary* on each of the next three beads.

Say the *Glory Be*

For each of the five decades, announce the Mystery (perhaps followed by a brief reading from Scripture) then say the *Our Father*.

While fingering each of the ten beads of the decade, next say ten *Hail Marys* while meditating on the Mystery. Then say a *Glory Be*.

(After finishing each decade, some say the following prayer requested by the Blessed Virgin Mary at Fatima: *O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell; lead all souls to Heaven, especially those who have most need of your mercy.*)

After saying the five decades, say the *Hail, Holy Queen*, followed by this dialogue and prayer:

V. Pray for us, O holy Mother of God.

R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

*Let us pray: O God, whose Only Begotten Son, by his life, Death, and Resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life, grant, we beseech thee, that while meditating on these mysteries of the most holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.*

Conclude the Rosary with the Sign of the Cross.

## El Rezo del Rosario

Familiarizarse con las oraciones del rosario.

Hacer el señal de la Cruz.

Sosteniendo el Crucifijo, digamos el credo de los Apóstoles.

En el primer cuenta, decir un Padre Nuestro.

Decir un Ave María en cada uno de los próximos tres cuentas y luego.

Decir la Gloria al Padre . . .

Para cada una de las cinco décadas, anunciar el misterio (quizás seguida por una lectura breve de la escritura) y, a continuación, decir el Padre Nuestro.

Mientras se recite cada uno de las diez cuentas, digamos 10 Ave Marías meditando en el misterio. A continuación, se dice Gloria.

(Después de terminar cada década, se dice la siguiente oración pedida por la Virgen en Fátima: Oh Jesús mío, perdona nuestros pecados, libranos del fuego del infierno, lleva a todas las almas al Cielo, especialmente aquellas que tienen más necesidad de tu misericordia.)

Después de pronunciar los cinco, misterios, se dice La Salve: Dios Salve, Reina, seguido por este diálogo y oración:

V. Ruega por nosotros, santa Madre de Dios.

R. Para que seamos dignos de alcanzar las promesas de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo. Amen.

Oremos: Oh Dios, cuyo Hijo Unigénito,  
por su vida, su muerte y resurrección,  
ha comprado para nosotros las recompensas de la vida eterna,  
Concédenos, nos implorararte  
que meditando sobre estos misterios  
del Santísimo Rosario de la Bienaventurada Virgen María,  
imitar lo que contienen  
y obtener lo que prometen,  
por el mismo Cristo nuestro Señor. Amén.

Concluir el rosario con el señal de la Cruz.
