The Relics of the Mexican Martyrs are Visiting

Corpus Christi

History of the Knights of Columbus Mexican Martyrs



The 1920s brought a revolution to Mexico, along with the widespread persecution of Catholics.

Missionaries were expelled from the country, Catholic seminaries and schools were closed, and the Church was forbidden to own property. Priests and laymen were told to denounce Jesus and their faith in public; if they refused, they faced not just punishment but torture and death.

During this time of oppression and cruelty, the Knights of Columbus did not retreat in Mexico but grew dramatically, from 400 members in 1918 to 43 councils and 6,000 members just five years later. In the United States at the time, the Knights handed out five million pamphlets that described the brutality of the Mexican government toward Catholics. As a result, the Mexican government greatly feared and eventually outlawed the Order.

Thousands of men, many of whom were Knights, would not bow to these threats or renounce their faith, and they often paid with their lives. They took a stand when that was the most difficult thing they could do, and their courage and devotion have echoed down through the decades. Here are some of the stories of the Knights of Columbus who joined the ranks of the Mexican Martyrs and were among the 25 victims of religious persecution canonized in 2000 by Pope John Paul II.

In 2005, 100 years after the first council in Mexico was formed, the anniversary was commemorated by a nationwide tour throughout Mexico of the relics of the Mexican martyrs that were given to the Knights of Columbus in 2001. At the centennial convention in Mexico City, Supreme Knight Carl Anderson declared that the Knights of Mexico are "second to none" in their devotion to "our founding ideals and their devotion to the Catholic faith."

PRAYER TO THE KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS MEXICAN MARTYRS

Almighty God, the martyrdom of Andrés Solá and José Trinidad Rangel, priests and Knights of Columbus, reveals that violence and hatred are only overcome by the spirit of peace and charity; and it manifests your love for the nation of the Guadalupana. These brother Knights live on in our minds and hearts for, as they sacrificed their lives for the sake of the Gospel, they witnessed that your love is eternal and your truth can never be compromised. Let their death-cry of fidelity to Jesus Christ encourage us to be courageous in faith and to remain loyal Knights of Columbus. We make our prayer through Christ our Lord. Amen.

Los Mártires Mexicanos Visitan Nuestra Parroquia

Historia de los Mártires Mexicanos de Caballeros de Colón

Beatos Mártires Caballeros de Colón En el 2005, tres miembros de la Orden también mártires fueron beatificados por el Papa Benedicto XVI junto con otros 10 mártires: José Trinidad Rangel Montaña, sacerdote diocesano de León y miembro del consejo 2484 de San Felipe, Guanajuato; Andrés Solá Molist, sacerdote claretiano español, miembro del consejo 1962 de León, Guanajuato; Leonardo Pérez Larios, laico, y miembro también del consejo 1962. Juntos los tres fueron ejecutados por su fe en abril de 1927, en el Rancho de San Joaquín, México.



Sus restos se encuentran al pie del cerro del Cubilete, en el Santuario Santa María Reina de los Mártires. El contenido histórico y biográfico fue adaptado del libro “By Their Works” de Stephen Singular y del libro “Tuyo es el Reino” de Mons. Ramiro Valdés Acerca de la Peregrinación de las Reliquias Durante su instalación como Caballero Supremo de la Orden en 2001, en la Basílica de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe en Cd. de México, Carl And Acerca de la Peregrinación de las Reliquias Durante su instalación como Caballero Supremo de la Orden en 2001, en la Basílica de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe en Cd. de México, Carl Anderson recibió un relicario de plata en forma de cruz que contiene las reliquias de los seis Santos Sacerdotes Mártires Mexicanos, Caballeros de Colón.

Durante esta ceremonia el Caballero Supremo dedicó solemnemente su administración y toda la Orden de Caballeros de Colón a la maternal intercesión y protección de Santa María de Guadalupe. En septiembre de 2005, para conmemorar el centenario de la fundación de la Orden en México, la Junta de Directores Supremos inició en Cd. de México una peregrinación del relicario a través de toda la Orden. El relicario viajó a varias ciudades en todo México y continuó su visita a los Estados Unidos.

La peregrinación concluyó en agosto de 2006 en Orlando durante la 124ª Convención Suprema. Esta nueva peregrinación busca dar a conocer en los EEUU el testimonio de entrega y amor de estos sacerdotes mártires mexicanos Caballeros de Colón y de todos aquellos que sacrificaron sus vidas por su fe durante la persecución religiosa en México.

Que su grito de fidelidad a Cristo Rey al momento de su martirio nos aliente a ser valientes testigos de la fe y permanecer leales Caballeros de Colón. Te lo pedimos por Cristo nuestro Señor. Amén
