Pope Francis: Pray the rosary daily for Church's protection from Satan

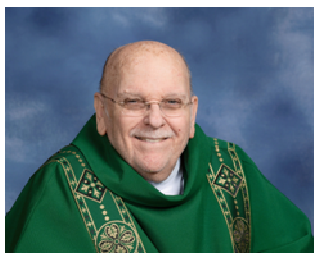
Vatican City, Sep 29, 2018 / 08:23 am (CNA).- Pope Francis has asked all Catholics to pray the rosary daily during the month of October, asking Mary and St. Michael the Archangel to intercede for the protection of the Church in a moment of “spiritual turbulence.” A Sept. 29 statement from the Vatican said that Pope Francis had recently affirmed that prayer “is the weapon against the Great Accuser who ‘goes around the world seeking to accuse.’ Only prayer can defeat him.” “The Russian mystics and the great saints of all the traditions advised, in moments of spiritual turbulence, to shelter beneath the mantle of the Holy Mother of God,” the statement added. The pope said that recitation of the rosary would invoke Mary's intercession, placing the Church under her “protective mantle.” The statement also encouraged the prayer of Sub Tuum Praesidium: “*We fly to Thy protection, O Holy Mother of God. Do not despise our petitions in our necessities, but deliver us always from all dangers, O Glorious and Blessed Virgin.*”

Pope Francis also encouraged that Catholics end the rosary with the recitation of the prayer to St. Michael the Archangel, composed by Pope Leo XII: “*Saint Michael Archangel, defend us in battle, be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil; may God rebuke him, we humbly pray; and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly host, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who prowl through the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.*”

Youth to Meet with Pope Francis during October Synod

Vatican City, Sep 18, 2018 / 10:21 am (CNA/EWTN News).- The Synod of Bishops has begun on October 3rd. Taking place starting at 5:00 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 6, the encounter is intended to allow “young people to offer concrete experiences about their life in study and work, their feelings, their future and their vocational choice,” a press release stated. Pope Francis will be present for the entirety of the encounter, which follows a pre-synod gathering that was held at the Vatican in March, with around 300 youth participants. The press statement noted that Pope Francis wants to meet young people again with the Synod Fathers to listen to them and to consider their proposals for the final document of the synod.

The gathering will include testimonies from young people interspersed with musical and artistic performances and will focus on three themes: the search for identity, relationships, and life as service and gift. “Young people are particularly invited, and we hope they will be numerous in order to make their voice and their warmth heard by the Synod Assembly,” the statement read. The Extraordinary Assembly of the Synod of Bishops will take place Oct. 3-28. According to its preparatory document, the synod’s purpose is to reflect on the Church’s call “to accompany all young people, without exception, towards the joy of love.”



Deacon Jay Milam was born January 1, 1945 and died September 30, 2018. He was ordained a deacon for the Diocese of Orange on May 19, 1990. He retired and moved to Fruitland to be near his mother and sister. He began serving here at Corpus Christi in 2015.

He will be buried in California with his wife. Services will be held at St. Juliana's Church (1316 N. Acacia Ave., Fullerton, CA 92831). There will be a Vigil Service on Monday, October 8th and the Funeral Mass will be Tuesday, October 9th at 10:00 a.m. The burial will be that day at 2:00 p.m. at Good Shepherd Cemetery.

We will have a Memorial Mass for Deacon Jay on Saturday, October 27th at the 5:00 p.m. Mass.

Please pray for the repose of the soul of Deacon Jay and for the consolation of his family and friends.

El Papa pide rezar el Rosario y a San Miguel en octubre para proteger a la Iglesia del demonio

El Papa Francisco ha invitado a los fieles de todo el mundo a rezar el Rosario todos los días del mes mariano de octubre, pidiendo la intercesión de la Virgen María y San Miguel Arcángel para que protejan la Iglesia del demonio en estos tiempos de crisis. En un comunicado emitido por la Santa Sede este 29 de septiembre, se expresa el pedido del Pontífice para que todo el pueblo de Dios se una “en comunión y penitencia” y rece por protección ante las acechanzas del maligno, “que siempre pretende separarnos de Dios y entre nosotros”. El Papa dijo en una homilía en Santa Marta del 11 de septiembre, que esta oración es “el arma” contra el demonio y que solo con la oración se le puede derrotar. “Los místicos rusos y los grandes santos de todas las tradiciones aconsejaron, en momentos de turbulencia espiritual, protegerse bajo el manto de la Santa Madre de Dios pronunciando la invocación ‘Sub Tuum Praesidium’”, aseguró.

La oración Sub Tuum Praesidium es la siguiente: “Bajo tu amparo nos acogemos, santa Madre de Dios; no deseches las súplicas que te dirigimos en nuestras necesidades, antes bien, líbranos de todo peligro, ¡oh siempre Virgen, gloriosa y bendita!”. El comunicado sostiene que, con esta solicitud de intercesión, el Papa pide a los fieles que recen para que María “ponga a la Iglesia bajo su manto protector”, y no solo la defienda, sino que la haga “más consciente de las culpas, de los errores, de los abusos cometidos en el presente y en el pasado y comprometida a luchar sin ninguna vacilación para que el mal no prevalezca”.

La otra oración que pide rezar el Santo Padre al finalizar cada Rosario, es la de San Miguel Arcángel creada por el Papa León XIII: “San Miguel Arcángel, defiéndenos en la lucha. Sé nuestro amparo contra la perversidad y acechanzas del demonio. Que Dios manifieste sobre él su poder, es nuestra humilde súplica. Y tú, oh Príncipe de la Milicia Celestial, con el poder que Dios te ha conferido, arroja al infierno a Satanás, y a los demás espíritus malignos que vagan por el mundo para la perdición de las almas. Amén”.

Ha Comenzado en Roma el Sínodo de los Obispos.

Después de meses de preparativos, comenzó en Roma este miércoles 3 de octubre la XV Asamblea General Ordinaria del Sínodo de los Obispos centrada en los jóvenes, la fe y el discernimiento vocacional. El Papa Francisco presidió la Misa de apertura del Sínodo, Misa de gran solemnidad que se desarrolló en gran parte en latín. En su homilía, el Santo Padre animó a los Padres Sinodales en los trabajos que comenzarán esta misma tarde, y les aseguró que “la Iglesia los mira con confianza y amor”. Los trabajos sinodales comenzarán este mismo miércoles 3 de octubre por la tarde con el discurso apertura que pronunciará el Papa Francisco. Se trata del tercer Sínodo convocado durante el presente Pontificado. El primero fue la III Asamblea General Extraordinaria y el segundo la XIV Asamblea General Ordinaria sobre el tema de la familia. Los trabajos del Sínodo abierto hoy se desarrollarán en tres unidades de trabajo bajo los epígrafes de “Reconocer: la Iglesia en escucha de la realidad”, “Interpretar: fe y discernimiento vocacional”, “Elegir: caminos de conversión pastoral y misionera”.



El Diácono Jay Milam nació el 1 de enero de 1945 y murió el 30 de septiembre de 2018. Fue ordenado diácono para la Diócesis de Orange el 19 de mayo de 1990. Se Jubilo y se mudó a Fruitland para estar cerca de su madre y su hermana. Comenzó a servir aquí en Corpus Christi en 2015.

Será su funeral en California y se pultado con su esposa. Los servicios se llevarán a cabo en la Iglesia de St. Juliana (1316 N. Acacia Ave., Fullerton, CA 92831). Habrá un servicio de vigilia el lunes 8 de octubre y la Misa fúnebre será el martes 9 de octubre a las 10:00 a.m. El entierro será ese día a las 2:00 p.m. en el Cementerio del Buen Pastor.

Tendremos una Misa en memoria de Deacon Jay el sábado 27 de octubre a las 5:00 p.m. Misa.
