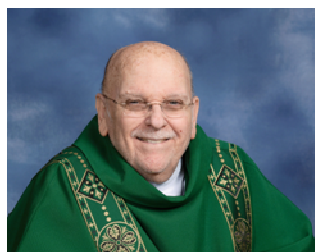
## About World Mission Sunday

Pope Francis issued his message for World Mission Day titled **“Together with young people, let us bring the Gospel to all”**. World Mission Sunday, organized by the *Society of the Propagation of the Faith*, is a day set aside for Catholics worldwide to recommit themselves to the Church’s missionary activity through prayer and sacrifice. During this year’s 90th anniversary, World Mission Sunday celebration relates its theme to the Year of Mercy, “Mercy Changes the World.” Pope Francis notes, “The mercy of God is His loving concern for each one of us.... As the Father loves, so do His children. Just as He is merciful, so we are called to be merciful to each other.”

Every year the needs of the Catholic Church in the Missions grow – as new dioceses are formed, as new seminaries are opened because of the growing number of young men hearing Christ’s call to follow Him as priests, as areas devastated by war or natural disaster are rebuilt, and as other areas, long suppressed, are opening up to hear the message of Christ and His Church. That is why the involvement and commitment of Catholics from around the world are so urgently needed. Offerings from Catholics in the United States, on World Mission Sunday and throughout the year, are combined with offerings to the Propagation of the Faith worldwide.

Mission dioceses – about 1,100 at this time – receive regular annual assistance from the funds collected. In addition, these mission dioceses submit requests to the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples for assistance, among other needs, for catechetical programs, seminaries, the work of Religious Communities, for communication and transportation needs, and for the building of chapels, churches, orphanages and schools. These needs are matched with the funds gathered in each year. The world’s national directors of the Propagation of the Faith vote on these requests, matching the funds available with the greatest needs. These funds are then distributed, in their entirety, to mission dioceses throughout the world.

Annually, World Mission Sunday is celebrated on the next-to-last Sunday in October. As described by Pope Saint John Paul II, World Mission Sunday is “an important day in the life of the Church because it teaches how to give: as an offering made to God, in the Eucharistic celebration and for all the missions of the world” (see *Redemptoris Missio* 81). Pope Saint John Paul II has also spoken of the Propagation of the Faith’s General Fund of support, calling this a “central fund of solidarity.” In a message delivered during a World Mission Sunday, the Pope said: “The offerings that will be collected [on World Mission Sunday] are destined for a common fund of solidarity distributed, in the Pope’s name, by the Society for the Propagation of the Faith among the missions and missionaries of the entire world.”



Deacon Jay Milam was born January 1, 1945 and died September 30, 2018. He was ordained a deacon for the Diocese of Orange on May 19, 1990. He retired and moved to Fruitland to be near his mother and sister. He began serving here at Corpus Christi in 2015.

He was buried in California with his wife. We will have a Memorial Mass for Deacon Jay on Saturday, October 27th at the 5:00 p.m. Mass.

Please pray for the repose of the soul of Deacon Jay and for the consolation of his family and friends.



## DOMUND 2018: “Cambia el mundo”

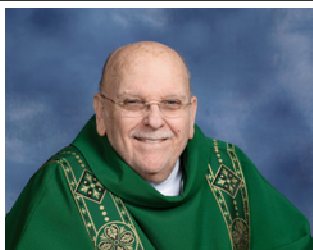
El **21 de octubre** es el Domingo Mundial de las Misiones, el **DOMUND**. Una jornada que organiza **Obras Misionales Pontificias** (OMP) para promover el compromiso de los cristianos para que el anuncio del Evangelio llegue a todos los ámbitos del mundo, junto con la promoción social que él conlleva. Un compromiso que se concreta en rezar y apoyar a los misioneros y en colaborar económicamente con los territorios en misión.

Este año 2018 se ha elegido el lema, “**Cambia el mundo**“. Por eso, desde OMP nos presentan “**historias que lo cambian todo**“. Los protagonistas son **Rosa, Chilo, Marlon, Paty, José Manuel Pancho**. Para todos el encuentro con **Patricio**, misionero en Honduras, hizo cambiar su historia. Ellos son la cara de esta Campaña. Pero con Patricio se visualiza la labor de los misioneros y misioneras españoles que son el ejemplo de que el cambio del mundo es posible y urgente. Rosa, Chilo, Marlon, Paty, José Manuel o Pancho representan a los cientos de personas que se han transformado y que ahora también transforman otras vidas.

**Octubre, mes misionero:** El 21 de octubre es el día central de una campaña que se desarrolla a lo largo de todo octubre, mes misionero. El lugar elegido para este año, Castilla y León. El 1 de octubre se inauguraba en Valladolid la **exposición “El DOMUND, al descubierto”** sobre la historia y la actividad misionera de la Iglesia en los cinco continentes. Esta exposición itinerante recorre Zamora, Segovia, Ávila, Ciudad Rodrigo y Salamanca. También está programada una amplia agenda de actos en diversas diócesis para dar la palabra a los misioneros.

**OMP también hace públicos los datos:** Obras Misionales Pontificias hace público un **dosier de prensa** y un **tríptico** en los que da a conocer los datos y las cuentas de la Campaña, entre ellos:

- 12. 000 misioneros españoles en 132 países.
- 1.108 territorios de misión, en los que vive casi la mitad de la población mundial.
- En 2017 se ha enviado 11.263.397,81 euros; se ha apoyado 644 proyectos y se ha beneficiado a 44 países.



El Diácono Jay Milam nació el 1 de enero de 1945 y murió el 30 de septiembre de 2018. Fue ordenado diácono para la Diócesis de Orange el 19 de mayo de 1990. Se Jubilo y se mudó a Fruitland para estar cerca de su madre y su hermana. Comenzó a servir aquí en Corpus Christi en 2015.

Fue funeral en California y se pultado con su esposa. Tendremos una Misa en memoria de Deacon Jay el sábado 27 de octubre a las 5:00 p.m. Misa.

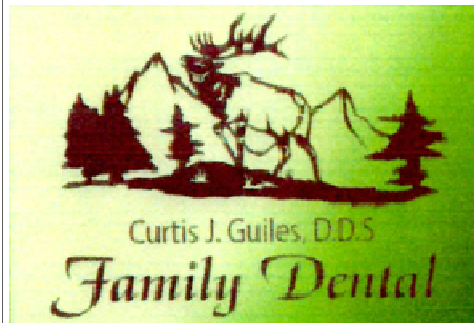
