Fr. Camilo's Pastoral Letter for the Month of November

Dear Parishioners, Parishioners of Corpus Christi, "Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ".

The month of November is dedicated to the **Souls in Purgatory**, whose memorial is celebrated on November 2nd. The entire month of November falls during the liturgical season known as Ordinary Time and is represented by the liturgical color green. As we come to the end of the Church Liturgical year is the Feast of Christ the King. "This feast asserts the supreme authority of Christ over human beings and their institutions.... Beyond it we see Advent dawning with its perspective of the Lord's coming in glory."— *The Liturgy and Time*, A.G. Mortimort *On Mach 19th the Solemnity of St. Joseph in the year 2018*. Pope Francis published another Apostolic Exhortation, It is Call "GAUDETE ET EXSULTATE" ON THE CALL TO HOLINESS IN TODAY'S WORLD. I want to share with you some paragraphs from the Apostolic Exhortation.

THE SAINTS WHO ENCOURAGE AND ACCOMPANY US: 3. The Letter to the Hebrews presents a number of testimonies that encourage us to "run with perseverance the race that is set before us" (12:1). It speaks of Abraham, Sarah, Moses, Gideon and others (cf. 11:1-12:3). Above all, it invites us to realize that "a great cloud of witnesses" (12:1) impels us to advance constantly towards the goal. These witnesses may include our own mothers, grandmothers or other loved ones (cf. *2 Tim* 1:5). Their lives may not always have been perfect, yet even amid their faults and failings they kept moving forward and proved pleasing to the Lord. **4.** The saints now in God's presence preserve their bonds of love and communion with us. The Book of Revelation attests to this when it speaks of the intercession of the martyrs: "I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the witness they had borne; they cried out with a loud voice, 'O sovereign Lord, holy and true, how long will it be before you judge?'" (6:9-10). Each of us can say: "Surrounded, led and guided by the friends of God... I do not have to carry alone what, in truth, I could never carry alone. All the saints of God are there to protect me, to sustain me and to carry me".[1]

THE LORD CALLS: 10. All this is important. Yet with this Exhortation I would like to insist primarily on the call to holiness that the Lord addresses to each of us, the call that he also addresses, personally, to you: "Be holy, for I am holy" (*Lev* 11:44; cf. *1 Pet* 1:16). The Second Vatican Council stated this clearly: "Strengthened by so many and such great means of salvation, all the faithful, whatever their condition or state, are called by the Lord – each in his or her own way – to that perfect holiness by which the Father himself is perfect".[10] **11.** "Each in his or her own way" the Council says. We should not grow discouraged before examples of holiness that appear unattainable. There are some testimonies that may prove helpful and inspiring, but that we are not meant to copy, for that could even lead us astray from the one specific path that the Lord has in mind for us. The important thing is that each believer discern his or her own path, that they bring out the very best of themselves, the most personal gifts that God has placed in their hearts (cf. *1 Cor* 12:7), rather than hopelessly trying to imitate something not meant for them. We are all called to be witnesses, but there are many actual ways of bearing witness.[11] Indeed, when the great mystic, Saint John of the Cross, wrote his *Spiritual Canticle*, he preferred to avoid hard and fast rules for all. He explained that his verses were composed so that everyone could benefit from them "in his or her own way".[12] For God's life is communicated "to some in one way and to others in another".[13]

Carta Pastoral del P. Camilo par el mes de Noviembre 2018.

Estimados Feligreses de Corpus Christi, Paz, Gracia y Bendicion de Parte de Dios Nuestro Señor y de Cristo Jesus. Permitanme compartirles esta explicacion sobre esta Nueva Exhortación Apóstolica.

El Papa Francisco publica su Nueva Exhortación Apostólica sobre el llamado a la Santidad. “*Gaudete et exsultate*, sobre el llamado a la santidad en el mundo actual” es la tercera exhortación apostólica del Papa Francisco –después de *Evangelii gaudium* y de *Amoris laetitia*– y de su Pontificado, que acaba de cumplir 5 años.

En la introducción, el Papa explica que “el Señor lo pide todo, y lo que ofrece es la verdadera vida, la felicidad para la cual fuimos creados”. “Él nos quiere santos y no espera que nos conformemos con una existencia mediocre, aguada, licuada. En realidad, desde las primeras páginas de la Biblia está presente, de diversas maneras, el llamado a la santidad. Así se lo proponía el Señor a Abraham: 'Camina en mi presencia y sé perfecto'”. Francisco explica que el nuevo documento no es “un tratado sobre la santidad, con tantas definiciones y distinciones que podrían enriquecer este importante tema, o con análisis que podrían hacerse acerca de los medios de santificación”. “Mi humilde objetivo es hacer resonar una vez más el llamado a la santidad, procurando encarnarlo en el contexto actual, con sus riesgos, desafíos y oportunidades. Porque a cada uno de nosotros el Señor nos eligió ‘para que fuésemos santos e irreprochables ante él por el amor’”, añade. La Exhortación, que puede leerse en el sitio web del Vaticano, se divide en 5 capítulos: El llamado a la santidad; Dos sutiles enemigos de la santidad; A la luz del maestro; Algunas notas de la santidad en el mundo actual; Combate, vigilancia y discernimiento, todos ellos repartidos en 177 puntos.

Se trata además el primer documento de este tipo que está dirigido en primera persona al lector. El Papa incluso pregunta si “¿eres consagrada o consagrado? Sé santo viviendo con alegría tu entrega. ¿Estás casado? Sé santo amando y ocupándote de tu marido o de tu esposa, como Cristo lo hizo con la Iglesia. ¿Eres un trabajador? Sé santo cumpliendo con honradez y competencia tu trabajo al servicio de los hermanos. ¿Eres padre, abuela o abuelo? Sé santo enseñando con paciencia a los niños a seguir a Jesús. ¿Tienes autoridad? Sé santo luchando por el bien común y renunciando a tus intereses personales”. **Santos "de la puerta de al lado"**. “En la Iglesia, santa y compuesta de pecadores, encontrarás todo lo que necesitas para crecer hacia la santidad”, añade después de estas preguntas. Francisco pide pensar en “los santos de la puerta de al lado”, es decir, no solo en los “ya beatificados o canonizados”. “Me gusta ver la santidad en el pueblo de Dios paciente: en esta constancia para seguir adelante día a día, veo la santidad de la Iglesia militante. La santidad ‘de la puerta de al lado’; ‘la clase media de la santidad’”. El Pontífice destaca que “cada santo es una misión; es un proyecto del Padre para reflejar y encarnar, en un momento determinado de la historia, un aspecto del Evangelio”. En este ejercicio de la santidad, “no es sano amar el silencio y rehuir el encuentro con el otro, desear el descanso y rechazar la actividad, buscar la oración y menospreciar el servicio”, por lo que la relación con el prójimo es fundamental.

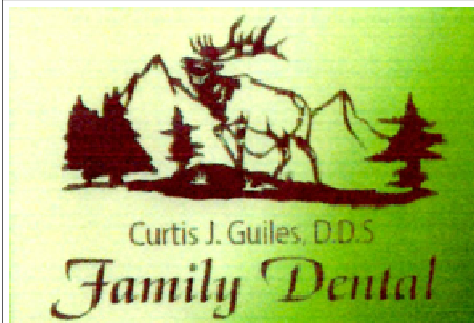
