ADVENT

Beginning the Church's liturgical year, Advent (from, ad-venire" in Latin or "to come to") is the season encompassing the four Sundays (and weekdays) leading up to the celebration of Christmas.

The Advent season is a time of preparation that directs our hearts and minds to Christ's second coming at the end of time and also to the anniversary of the Lord's birth on Christmas. The final days of Advent, from December 17 to December 24, focus on our preparation for the celebrations of the Nativity of our Lord (Christmas).

Advent devotions including the Advent wreath, remind us of the meaning of the season.



Celebrating with the Advent Wreath

One way to prepare for Christ's coming into our lives is to make an Advent wreath for your daily household worship. This traditional circular wreath reminds us that God, like the circle, has no beginning and no end. Evergreens on the wreath symbolize our everlasting relationship with God, the source of continuous new life.

The wreath has four candles, three purple or violet and one rose. On the First Sunday and week of Advent we light the first candle and then an additional candle each Sunday until Christmas. Purple is a royal color, reflecting the kingship of Christ and also repentance. The rose candle, lit on the Third Sunday of Advent, represents joy. The candles also remind us that the incarnation has transformed the darkness of hatred and evil into the light of joy and love. Let your Advent wreath become the center around which your household gathers together each night during this joyous, but sometimes frenzied, season of celebration. And as you celebrate with the Advent wreath, include your favorite Advent hymns and songs, scripture readings and prayers focusing on Christ's threefold Advent – past, present and future.

An Advent Wreath Prayer

"Come Jesus, come. Give power to light and to good. Come where falsehood, ignorance of God, violence and injustice dominate. Come Lord Jesus, give power to the good in the world and help us be bearers of your light, peacemakers, witnesses of the truth. Come, Lord Jesus!" Amen - - Pope Benedict XVI

ADVIENTO

Al comenzar el año litúrgico de la Iglesia, el Adviento (desde “ad-venire en latín o “venir a”) es la temporada que abarca los cuatro domingos (y entre semana) que condujo a la celebración de la Navidad.

El Adviento es un tiempo de preparación que dirige nuestros corazones y nuestras mentes a la segunda venida de Cristo al final de los tiempos y también el aniversario del nacimiento de nuestro Señor en la Navidad. Los últimos días del Adviento, del 17 de diciembre al 24 de diciembre, se centran particularmente en nuestra preparación para la celebración de la Natividad de Nuestro Señor (Navidad).

Devociones de Adviento incluyendo la Corona de Adviento, nos recuerdan el sentido de la temporada.



Celebrando con la Corona de Adviento

Una manera de prepararse para la venida de Cristo en nuestras vidas es prepara una corona de Adviento en nuestro hogar para seguir nuestra adoración. Este tradicional corona circular nos recuerda que Dios, como círculo, no tiene principio ni fin. El verde hoja en la Corona simbolizan nuestra relación eterna con Dios, fuente continua de nueva vida.

La Corona tiene cuatro velas, tres púrpura o violeta y una rosa. El primer domingo de Adviento, y en la semana tenemos la primera luz de vela y una vela adicional en cada domingo hasta Navidad. Púrpura es un color real, reflejando la realeza de Cristo y también el arrepentimiento. La vela rosa iluminado en el tercer domingo de Adviento, representa la alegría. Así, los colores de las velas ilustrar los temas de Adviento: monarquía, arrepentimiento y alegría. Las velas también nos recuerda que la encarnación ha transformado la oscuridad del odio y del mal a la luz de la alegría y el amor. Deje que su Corona de Adviento se convierta en el centro del cual su familia se reúne cada noche durante esta alegre, pero a veces frenético, temporada de celebración. Y celebran con la Corona de Adviento, incluyen himnos y cantos, oraciones y lecturas de la Escritura centrada en Cristo triple advenimiento pasados, presentes y futuros.

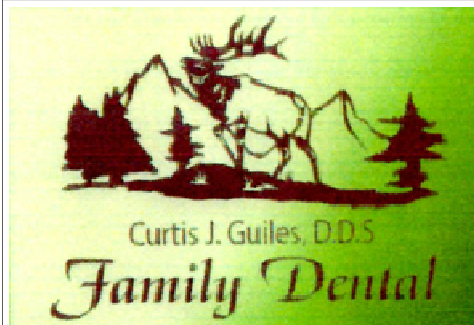
